- that suitable arrangements are in place for the storage, handling, transport and processing of materials to prevent pollution.
- plant and equipment are maintained to prevent spillages, dust and fumes emissions to air and mitigate the environmental impacts.
- adequate training, procedures and supervision are in place to ensure that personnel and contractors are competent to carry out their duties with respect to environmental protection.
- effective emergency response plans are in place to mitigate the consequences of any pollution incident.
- the company fulfils its compliance obligations.
- arrangements are in place for adequate waste storage and its disposal and / or recycling.
- that open dialogue is maintained with employees, neighbouring communities, regulatory authorities, contractors, and any other interested parties on environmental protection.
- that we continually look to improve the effectiveness of the EMS to enhance the environmental performance of the company.



All employees shall be aware of this policy, the environmental objectives and what is expected of them in their role at Chemson Ltd, and that they understand that if they encounter an issue which is not documented, or something that they are unsure of; they should raise it with an appropriate manager.
